Security

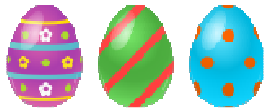
Please can we remind you of the importance of ensuring the main doors to the nursery are closed when you enter or leave the building.

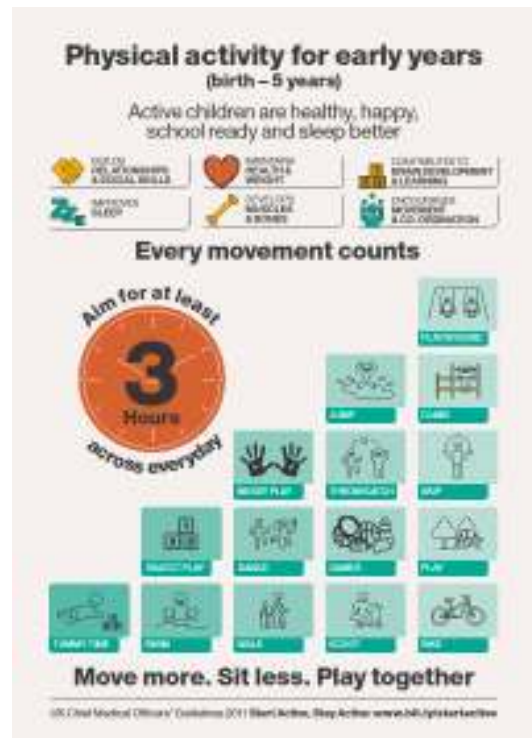
Just a reminder, Kathryn Winter is your parent representative.
